

Full Capacity – “Planosicht” week planner

The WEIGANG **week planner** always informs everybody in the company about the tasks to be carried out and when they are due. An efficient scheduling order during the week almost automatically results in high capacity utilization, schedule effectiveness and customer satisfaction.

The **week planner** designed by the visualisation and organisation specialist WEIGANG is an application version of the proven “**Planosicht**” scheduling board system that has been successful in practice so many times. It consists of modular board elements which can be used to form scheduling boards of any size. A board which is 1260 mm in width and 480 mm in height is appropriate for one-week coordination of 30 employees or two-week management of 15 employees. Individual reorganisation or future expansion of the board is possible at any time and without any problem.



Cardboard strips for identification of project or processing phases

The **week planner** is provided with self-clipping profile sections, which receive write-on signal strips of cardboard in various colours. These cardboard strips identify project phases or other time intervals. They also allow to mark special dates, such as targets dates, with clip-on coloured plastic tabs. If you wish to change your schedules, you will find the system extremely flexible: just remove, shift and re-sort the cardboard strips and tabs in a jiffy.

Precise scaling

The board can be scaled at its upper edge, for example by workdays from Monday to Friday, with each workday subdivided in eight hourly fields. This is entirely adequate for scheduling many project runs or production, repair and other workflows but you can, of course, also select higher precision if you wish. One horizontal line is assigned to each project, employee or workplace. The overall board indicates the state of the project, the utilization and capacity of the company, the department or the working group over several days. Absence times or imminent organisational slacks are visible straight away.

Company timetable for more transparency

Meetings with many-headed teams can take place in front of the large-size “company timetable”. The prominent display elements reveal relationships at a glance and from a distance. Where are bottlenecks in the orders to be processed? Which machine can be serviced and when? Who can take a short holiday break?

In contrast to software scheduling systems, a scheduling board is accessible to every employee at any time, without a computer having to be started or a password to be entered. The proven visualisation system is “timeless” and does not have to be updated. Its simple handling is easy to learn within a short time, which is of benefit particularly in cases of illness or during holiday seasons.

That is why it is not surprising that, in recent years, business consultants have again recommended the use of scheduling board.
